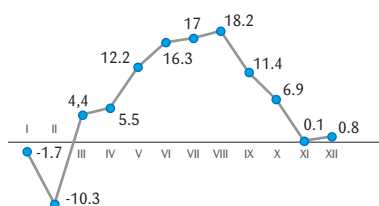

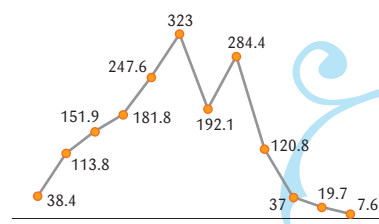

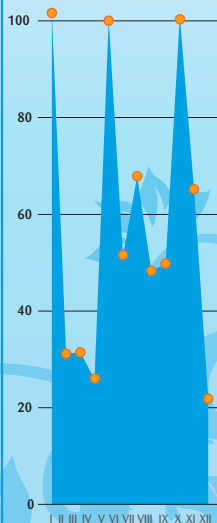

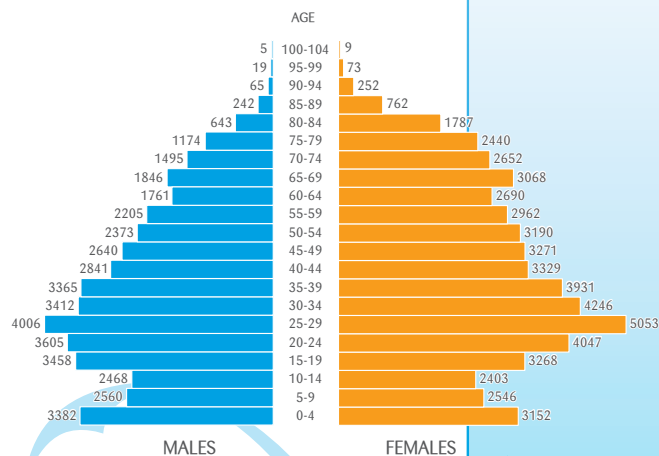

## Population by age and sex 1.01.2008

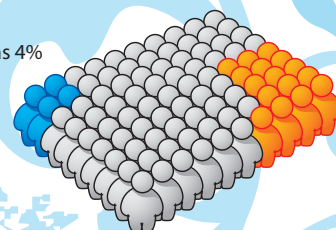

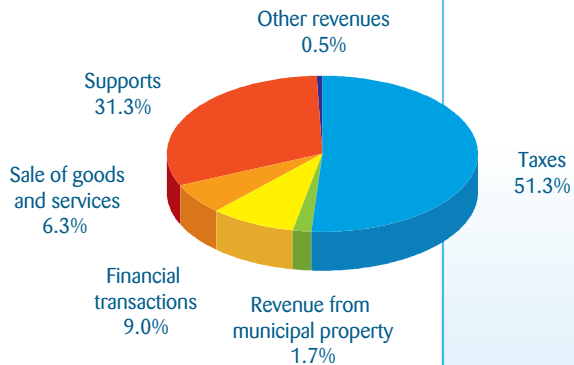

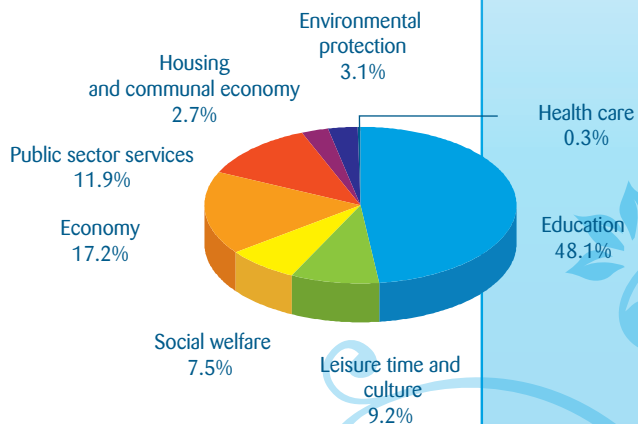
