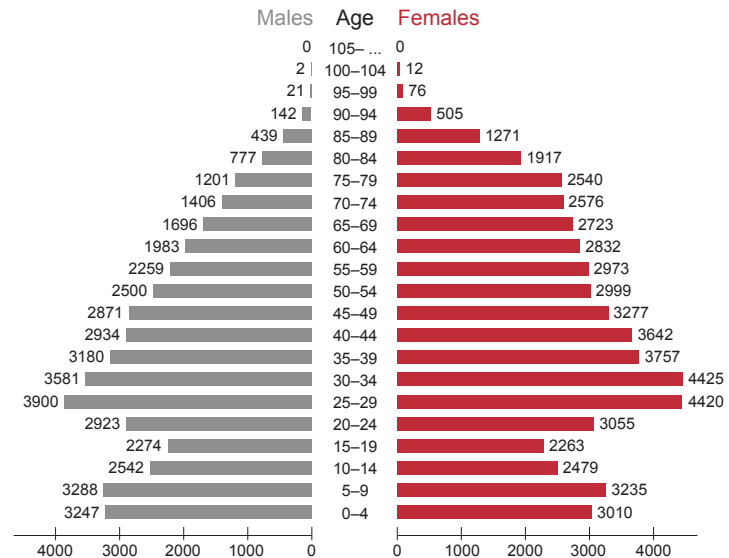

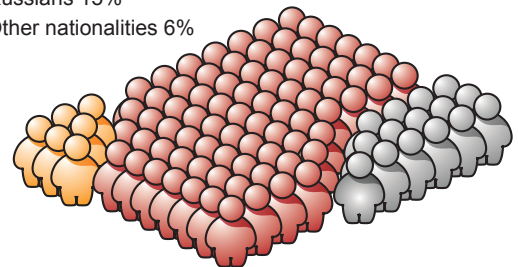

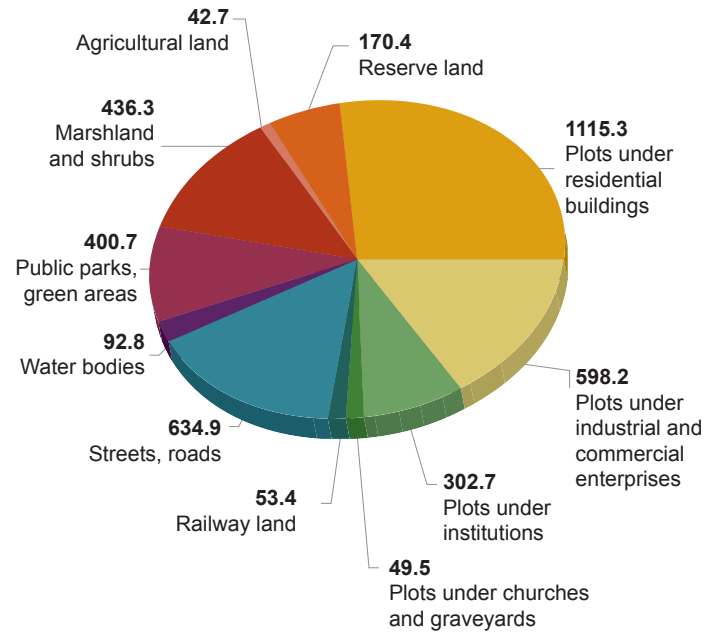

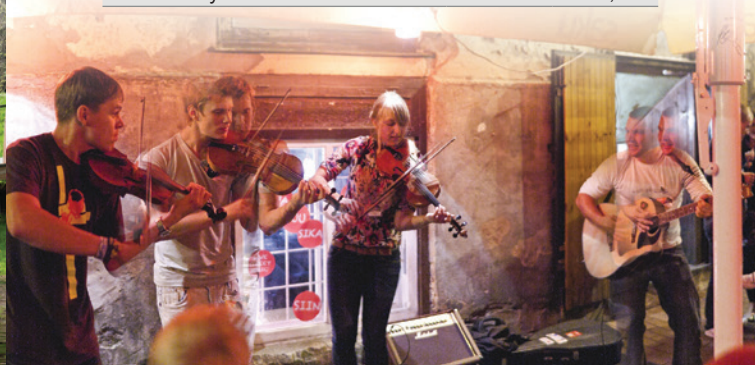

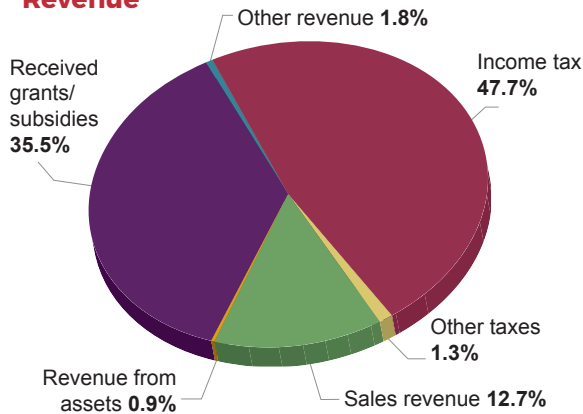

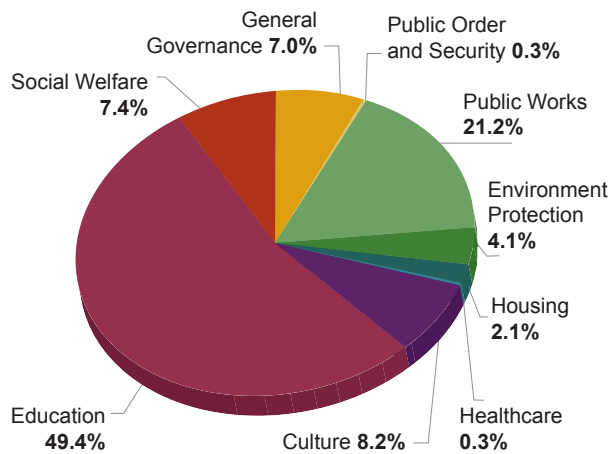


City of Tartu budget for 2016 (149 million euro)
